תּוֹרָה	<i>Torah*</i>	Law/teaching, Five Books of Moses
תנ"ך	<i>Tanakh</i>	Hebrew Bible – <i>Torah, N'vi'im, K'tuvim</i>
נְבִיאִים	<i>N'vi'im</i>	Prophets (section of the Bible)
כְּתוּבִים	<i>K'tuvim</i>	Writings (section of the Bible)
הַלְכָּה	<i>halakhah</i>	Jewish law; “the way to go”
מִשְׁנָה	<i>Mishnah</i>	Rabbinic writings of Jewish Oral Law; first part of <i>Talmud</i>
גְּמָרָא	<i>Gemara</i>	Rabbinic commentary on the <i>Mishnah</i> ; second part of <i>Talmud</i>
תַּלְמוּד	<i>Talmud</i>	Rabbinic books of legal codes, stories, debates, made of <i>Mishnah</i> and <i>Gemara</i>
פְּרָקֵי אָבוֹת	<i>Pirkei Avot</i>	Text about relationships and ethics; “Ethics of Our Sages”
