Hebrew	Transliteration	Translation/Description
בָּשָׂרִי	<i>b'sari</i>	Meat
חֲלָבִי	<i>halavi</i>	Dairy
פָּרוּוה	<i>parve</i>	(Yiddish) Neutral; neither meat nor dairy
טְרֵיף	<i>treif</i>	(Yiddish) Not kosher
הֶכְשֵׁר	<i>hekhsher</i>	Kosher certification approval
כָּשֵׁר	<i>kasher</i>	To make kosher; to make fit for use
כְּשָׁרוֹת	<i>kashrut</i>	Laws concerning status of food for eating and ritual; kosher
מַשְׁגִּיחַ	<i>mashgi-ah</i>	One who oversees <i>kashrut</i> status of kitchen
הֲלָכָה	<i>halakhah</i>	Jewish law; “the way to go”
