*tallit*

Prayer shawl

תְּפִלִּין

*t'fillin*

Phylacteries; the small black boxes worn on a person's head and arm during weekday morning services

צִיצִית

*tzitzit*

Fringes with knots tied onto *tallit*

מְזוּזָה

*m'zuzzah*

Scroll placed on door frame  
with words from the Torah inside

יָד

*yad*

Torah pointer; “hand”
