	יִישָׁר כֹּהֶנְךָ	<i>yishar ko-h’kha</i> colloquially pronounced: <i>yasher ko-ah</i>	Statement made to a male in response to something done well, especially after a Torah reading or <i>d’var Torah</i> ; “May your strength be made straight”
	יוֹם הוֹלֵדֶת שִׂמְחָה	<i>yom huledet same-ah</i>	Happy birthday
