פֶּסַח <i>Pesah</i> Passover	אַפִּיקוֹמָן	<i>afikoman*</i>	Dessert; hidden <i>matzah</i> that is searched for during <i>seder</i>
	בֵּיצָה	<i>beitzah*</i>	Egg
	דַּיֵינוּ	<i>dayeinu</i>	It would have been “enough for us”; a song in the <i>haggadah</i>
	הַגָּדָה	<i>haggadah*</i>	Book used for Passover <i>seder</i>
	חֶמֶץ	<i>hametz*</i>	Food containing grains forbidden on <i>Pesah</i>
	חֲרוֹסֶת	<i>haroset*</i>	A mixture that represents the mortar used by the Israelites in Egypt
	קַעֲרָה	<i>k'arah*</i>	Seder plate
	כַּרְפַּס	<i>karpas*</i>	Leafy greens
	מָרֹר	<i>maror*</i>	Bitter herb
	מַצָּה	<i>matzah*</i>	Unleavened bread
	מִצְרַיִם	<i>Mitzrayim</i>	Egypt

	עֹמֵר	<i>Omer</i>	Period of counting seven weeks between <i>Pesah</i> and <i>Shavu'ot</i>
	סֵדֶר	<i>seder</i> *	“Order”; ritual meal for <i>Pesah</i>
	זְרוּעַ	<i>z'ro-ah</i> *	Shank bone
Greeting	חַג שְׂמֵחַ	<i>hag same-ah</i> *	“Happy holiday”
