### JLV IS INTRODUCED IN LARGE GROUPS AND IN SPECIFIC CLASSES

2/3 of respondents share the vocabulary in an all-group setting (t'fillah, assembly, sometimes with parents present).

1/2 of respondents ask teachers to introduce content-relevant JLV into specific curriculum.

### JLV IS SHARED WITH OTHERS, BEYOND THE STUDENTS

Over 2/3 of educational programs have a visual display in a public location

> 1/3 share the word(s) of the week in a bulletin article or newsletter

## JLV IS OFTEN "ANCHORED"

50% of the respondents use a letter o the week to organize JLV word lists.

Almost all programs that introduce a letter of the week first share it all-group and then ask teachers to creatively reinforce the letter with their students.
