

Torah Service		
Hebrew	Transliteration	Translation/Description
עֲלִיָּה לַתּוֹרָה	<i>aliyah la'torah</i>	Calling up to the <i>bimah</i> to recite Torah blessings or read from Torah
בִּימָה	<i>bimah*</i>	Raised area in synagogue; can also refer to the pulpit
דְּבַר תּוֹרָה	<i>d'var Torah</i>	Sermon; "words of Torah"
דְּרָשָׁה	<i>d'rashah</i>	Interpretation or explication of Torah
עֵץ חַיִּים	<i>etz hayim</i>	Wooden handles of Torah scroll; "Tree of life"
גְּלִילָה	<i>g'lilah</i>	Dressing the Torah
גַּבְּאֵי	<i>gabbai</i>	One who helps with Torah service
הַפְּטָרָה	<i>Haftarah</i>	Reading from books of <i>Nevi'im</i> /Prophets accompanying the Torah portion
הַגְּבָהָה	<i>hagbahah</i> colloquially pronounced: <i>hagbah</i>	Raising of the Torah scroll
הַקְּפָה	<i>hakafah</i>	Going around or circling with Torah scrolls; Torah procession
מַפְטִיר	<i>maftir</i>	Concluding section of Torah reading; last Torah reader
פָּרָשָׁה	<i>parashah</i>	Portion of Torah
פָּרָשַׁת הַשְּׁבוּעַ	<i>parashat hashavu-a</i>	Torah portion of the week
