	אֵלוּ וְאֵלוּ	<i>eilu v'eilu</i>	Both this and that
	חַי	<i>hai</i>	Life; alive; living
	חֶסֶד	<i>hesed</i>	Kindness
	חֲצִפָּה	<i>hutzpah</i>	Nerve; guts; the quality of over-stepping boundaries with no shame
	קָדוֹשׁ	<i>kadosh</i>	Holy
	מְעַנְטֵשׁ	<i>mensch</i>	(Yiddish) A good person
	מְדוּת	<i>middot</i>	Values; virtues
	מִצְוָה	<i>mitzvah</i>	Commandment
